

Part Time General Music & Chorus Teacher (K-12)

General Description

The Music Teacher will work to build a vocal music program for PCS. He/she will lead and manage general music and chorus classes, design program curriculum, select music, and provide instruction for rehearsals and performances. The Music Teacher must be skilled in vocal music and music theory, and possess excellent communication and leadership skills.

Qualifications:

- Model a consistent daily walk with Jesus Christ in speech, actions, attitudes.
- Teach students to understand music, the use of musical instruments, and the basics of vocal performance.
- Lead rehearsals and prepare students for performances, including concerts, programs, and other school events.
- Foster a positive and supportive learning environment that encourages creativity, collaboration, and spiritual growth.
- Integrate Biblical principles into music instruction and classroom activities
- Strong understanding of music theory and pedagogy
- Music Education degree preferred; bachelor's degree required.
- Use valid teaching techniques to achieve curriculum goals and promote student learning.
- Plan a program of study that, as much as possible, meets the individual needs, interests, and abilities of the students, challenging each to do his or her best work.
- Teach classes as assigned following the prescribed scope and sequence.
- Prepare and submit weekly lesson plans for the administrator's review.
- Employ a variety of instructional aids, methods, and materials that will provide for creative teaching to reach the whole child—spiritual, intellectual, physical, social, emotional.
- Assess the learning of students on a regular basis and provides progress reports as required.
- Update student management system with student grades and progress.
- Communicate with parents as needed.
- Implement a discipline plan that correlates with the guidelines of the school.
- Possess the ability to adapt and be flexible with plans.
